*completion of *garden upgrades* in and around the Quadrangle and COLA. We thank Mrs Staines for overseeing these projects and acknowledge the work of Stephen McPhee and Rod McCallum in beautifying our school.

*commencement of *painting* around the school linked to the roofing project. This is on-going and will be completed in the next couple of weeks.

*installation of *new signage* and other features around the school including *Wiradjuri Totems* featuring artworks created by Parkview community member Mr William Ingram and the installation of totems in the newly restored *Peace Garden* that recognise current and former servicemen and women.

The NSW Government's announcement of a revision linked to COVID-19 Protocols means a number of things for our school. The following activities can now proceed (with strict COVID Protocols in place):
