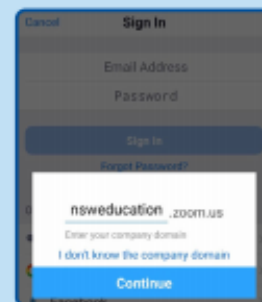

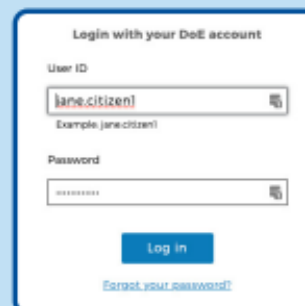

COVID Safe Protocols.

Please remember the following key points to ensure we all do everything we can to keep our community COVID-19 Free:

*** The border between NSW and Victoria closed as of 12:01am 8 July 2020. All staff and students returning from Victoria after this time must have a permit to enter NSW and are required to self-isolate for a period of 14 days.**

With the exception of staff and students who reside in a border town, all other staff and students who have been in Victoria in the 14 days before the commencement of school should not attend school until they complete the 14 days self-isolation period since they left Victoria.

NSW Health has requested anyone who has been in Victoria and is unwell or has flu like symptoms arrange to be tested through their local medical practitioner or one of the COVID-19 clinics.

*** We would like to remind parents and carers not to send students to school if they are unwell, even if they have mild symptoms. Schools will make appropriate arrangements to return students home if they become unwell at school. Students should be at school unless:**

- they have a medical certificate which states that they are unable to return to school due to an ongoing medical condition and the expected time frame
- they are currently unwell.

*** Please be aware that all visitors to the school during school hours will be required to sign a 'School Site Form' stating your name and phone number and/or email address. This form acts as a statement by you that you are aware of and will comply with the health advice of the day, including hygiene and social distancing requirements. This form will assist the school with contact traces if the need arises.**




