





# WEEK 1 TERM 4 Commencing Tuesday 5th October 2021

Welcome back to what we are confident will be an exciting and engaging Term 4 of learning at Parkview Public School. We trust that everyone has enjoyed a relaxing holiday period with family and friends.

Positively, during the holidays our Local Government Area has remained COVID-free and as such our school remains at Level 3 restrictions meaning we are learning face-to-face and adhering carefully to the Department of Education's Roadmap for returning to a 'new-normal' for schools.

Notes in the last week:

Much of today's newsletter is dedicated to our return to school protocols including the excitement of Kindergarten 2022 Transition commencing this week! Please consider the following as you plan your week:

# **Level 3 Return to School - Term 4**

School resumed for all children today. Our school will continue to operate under Level 3 conditions as part of our COVID-safe return to school roadmap. These are the same arrangements as for the final week of Term 3.

Below is a reminder what our families and students can expect when returning to school throughout the start of this term:

- Staff will be required to wear masks indoors and outdoors while on school grounds.
- We will reduce overall mingling of our different student years which means no school assemblies, sport (outside of existing class Sport and PDHPE), excursions or field trips.
- Students will play in stage groups in the playground. This means children will have a timetabled location for play throughout Week 1 of the term. When arriving at school, children should drop their bags at their classrooms and go directly to their scheduled play area (the playground timetable is attached to this email).
- Only essential visitors will be allowed on site and will always be required to check-in and wear masks.
- Our School Canteen is open with appropriate hygiene measures in place. Ordering will be available via classroom baskets or online ordering (preferred).
- Our P&C Uniform Shop is only available for over the phone orders under Level 3 restrictions. If you require any type of uniforms, please ring the school during designated Uniform Shop hours (Monday 9am-10am and Thursday 2pm-3pm) so your order can be processed. Orders can be picked up from the School Administration Office at a time that is identified when you place your orders.
- Parents and carers will need to remain outside of school grounds and follow physical distancing and avoid gathering for drop-offs and pick-ups.
- There will be enhanced daily cleaning of the school and wherever possible we will ensure classrooms will be well-ventilated with open windows.
- After School Care will be available on site following COVID-safe plans, run by Leeton Shire Council.

Students will play in stage groups in the playground. This means children will have a timetabled location for play throughout Week 1 of the term. When arriving at school, children should drop their bags at their classrooms and go directly to their scheduled play area.

### **Kindergarten 2022 Transition**

It is with great excitement that we confirm the information released by the Department of Education across the weekend that Kindergarten 2022 Transition can commence in Level 2 and Level 3 Schools across NSW.

Parkview Public School is currently operating under Level 3 restrictions as such we will commence our Kindergarten 2022 Transition Program tomorrow (Wednesday, 6th October). If you are yet to register your child for Kindergarten 2022 Transition or know someone who intends on doing so, we encourage you to contact the school.

### Below is a list of reminders regarding the transition program:

- \* The program will run in the Kindergarten Rooms (enter through the gates near the big pencils on Park Ave) from 11:30am-1:45pm daily. Parents and carers who are dropping children to Transition should enter the school via the infants gate and sign their child in at the table located outside the Transition Room. You will be able to collect your child from the same place at the conclusion of the program.
- \* Our complimentary bus service will run, supervised by Parkview staff. The bus timetable is attached to this email. Please note these times are approximate and will be adjusted as we assess the time it will take to navigate our route.
- \* Children who attend Bright Beginnings on Wednesdays will be accompanied by Parkview Staff from Bright Beginnings to our Transition Program at 11:30am.
- \* Kindergarten Transition T-Shirts (not compulsory) can be purchased for \$10 from the School Administration Office.
- \* Children should bring a *healthy lunch, drink bottle and hat* to all sessions. *Comfortable clothing* that are appropriate for the weather conditions and *practical closed-in shoes* (such as joggers) are encouraged.
- \* If your child has any emerging health conditions or an updated health care plan it is vital that you update the school prior to the commencement of Kindergarten 2022 Transition.

### Parent and carers are reminded to:

- \* Maintain physical distancing
- \* Check-in using a QR code and please do not remain on site longer than 10 minutes
- \* Follow relevant medical advice including wearing a mask

If you have any questions or concerns or would like to have your child added to the bus timetable for Week 2 and beyond, please do not hesitate to contact the school.

School Banking has been suspended at this time due to COVID restrictions. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.






