Kindergarten 2022 Transition

Kindergarten 2022 Transition Program continues tomorrow (Wednesday, 13th October). **If you are yet to register your child for Kindergarten 2022 Transition or know someone who intends on doing so, we encourage you to contact the school.**

Below is a list of reminders regarding the transition program:

* The program will run in the Kindergarten Rooms (enter through the gates near the big pencils on Park Ave) from 11:30am-1:45pm daily. **Parents and carers who are dropping children to Transition should enter the school via the infants gate and sign their child in at the table located outside the Transition Room. You will be able to collect your child from the same place at the conclusion of the program.**

* Our complimentary bus service will run, supervised by Parkview staff.

* Children who attend Bright Beginnings on Wednesdays will be accompanied by Parkview Staff from Bright Beginnings to our Transition Program at 11:30am.

* Kindergarten Transition T-Shirts (not compulsory) can be purchased for \$10 from the School Administration Office.

* Children should bring a **healthy lunch, drink bottle and hat** to all sessions. **Comfortable clothing** that are appropriate for the weather conditions and **practical closed-in shoes (such as joggers)** are encouraged.

* If your child has **any emerging health conditions or an updated health care plan** it is vital that you update the school prior to the commencement of Kindergarten 2022 Transition.

Parent and carers are reminded to:

* Maintain physical distancing

* Check-in using a QR code and please do not remain on site longer than 10 minutes

* Follow relevant medical advice including wearing a mask

If you have any questions or concerns or would like to have your child added to the bus timetable for Week 2 and beyond, please do not hesitate to contact the school.

It was awesome!

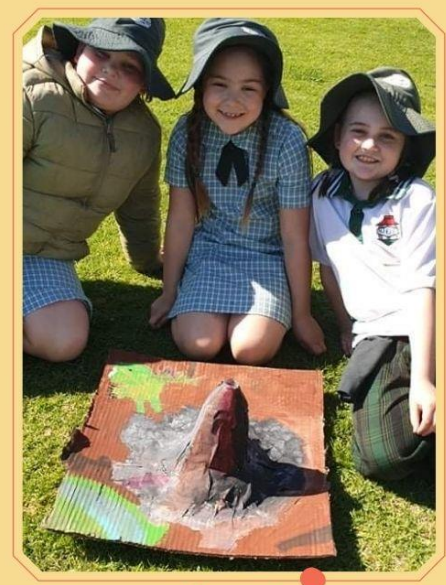

Welcome back to Term 4!

It has been wonderful to see so many students return to face to face learning this term. Term 4 has commenced under Level 3 restrictions. This means that students and staff are required to wear masks in all indoor settings. I am very pleased to say that a vast majority of students have been exceptional in their cooperation and adherence to the requirements around mask wearing indoors which plays a huge role in keeping us all safe and healthy.

As per Department guidelines, activities are restricted to established student groupings. We are ensuring that our students remain in class or year groupings where possible and have put measures in place to minimise interactions between groups at entry and exit points, transitioning between classes and during recess and lunch breaks to reduce contact between student cohorts including during sport time.

Non-essential visitors are not permitted onsite. Assemblies and excursions are also not permitted at this time. We will run our Year Meetings and whole school Assemblies online, in year groups, to avoid 'mingling' as per the guidelines. This online platform delivery still allows us to share communications and information across the school to everyone at the same time and for our Year Advisers to touch base with their years to maintain regular contact, to share information, or to engage in a focus or initiative to support learning and wellbeing.

Indigenous Garden

The Indigenous Garden has seen some progress over the course of this year thanks to our Aboriginal Education Team and our Boys' Cultural Group. The watering system has been updated, more plants have been added and two beautiful metal sculptures created by local artist Tobias Bennett have been installed. The first sculpture added was the 'Crow' sitting atop of one of the totem poles. The Crow is our local Indigenous clan's totem. The second sculpture is that of a Goanna. The Goanna is the totem for the Wiradjuri's Nation. Both sculptures are made from recycled metal and uniquely represent the spiritual aspect of the local Wiradjuri clan.



Positive Behaviour for Learning

This term, our Positive Behaviour for Learning focus will re-group around our values of being respectful, responsible, learners. We will refresh ourselves on what it is to be respectful and responsible in our environment (including appropriate behaviours at school and in social situations) and how not demonstrating our values negatively impacts on others. We will also be sharing positive strategies on showcasing our 'best self' in every environment. Students receiving PBL e-tickets for demonstrating our school values will have their names entered into electronic draws for weeks 5 and 10. This year our students have earned 25, 809 positive PBL e-tickets. A wonderful achievement by our staff and students.
