The last seven days were certainly full of experiences and events, none more important than the distribution of **Semester 2 Reports.** As always, if you have any questions in relation to your child's learning, please contact your child's teacher to arrange a mutually convenient meeting time.

Despite the interruptions endured in recent months, we have certainly attempted to cram as much as possible into the back end of the school year to ensure our children have been able to experience as many opportunities as possible. One of the major highlights is always the **Year 6 Workers Auction** and **Workers Day**, with last Monday's Workers Auction raising over \$1,500 for a Year 6 Gift for the school. The Year 6 kids had a great time participating last Monday, before heading to their **Year 6 Graduation Dinner** which was a wonderful celebration of the graduating Class of 2021! Congratulations to kids and thank you to a group of proud parents who were in attendance to enjoy the event last Monday evening.

Week 10 of the term was full of exciting events, quite possibly highlighted by the hosting of the **Stage 3 Excursions** to Griffith City Cinemas on Wednesday and the Whitton Malt House on Thursday. Our children received some wonderful feedback from our hosts and enjoyed two richly deserved days after overnight excursions were cancelled due to the COVID-19 Pandemic.

Last week also saw the conclusion of the highly beneficial **Kindergarten – Year 1 Swimming Scheme**. As the only school in the region to host a swimming program for our youngest students, we are grateful for the support we receive from parents and carers and proud of the efforts displayed by our K-1 students to develop their water confidence.

Last Friday was notable for the **2022 School Leaders Speeches and Elections**. We are incredibly proud of all 36 candidates who took a risk and got up on stage to deliver a leadership speech ahead of the elections. Whilst we can only appoint 16 leaders, the standard of responsibility and care displayed amongst all candidates was outstanding and we know we have wonderful leadership capacity amongst all of the students in our in-coming Year 6 class.

The final week of the year is always a busy, exciting and emotional one, and this week promises to be no different as we farewell staff and students and reflect upon and celebrate the achievements of the 2021 year. 


