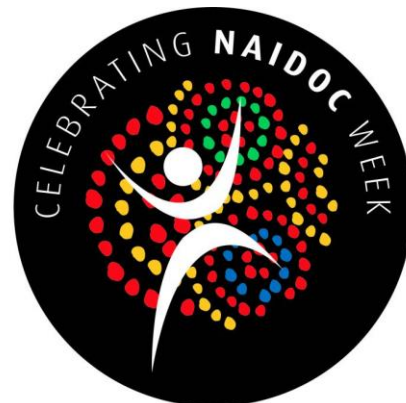

Kindergarten 2022 Transition is scheduled to commence on Wednesday, 18<sup>th</sup> August.

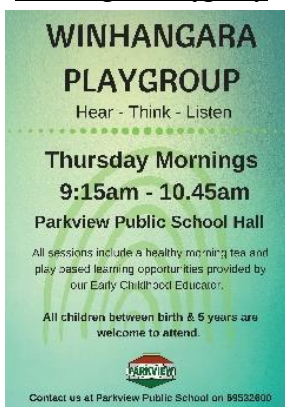
### **Bright Beginnings**

School Banking will continue every Tuesday! Why not involve your child in this wonderful financial literacy opportunity? Contact the school for more details on how to get your child involved.

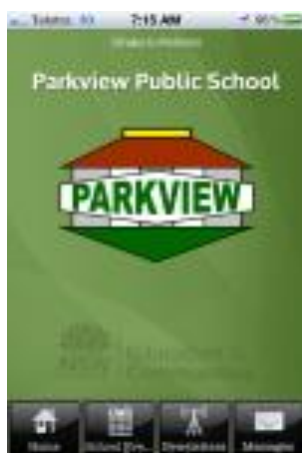


### **Following us on Facebook**

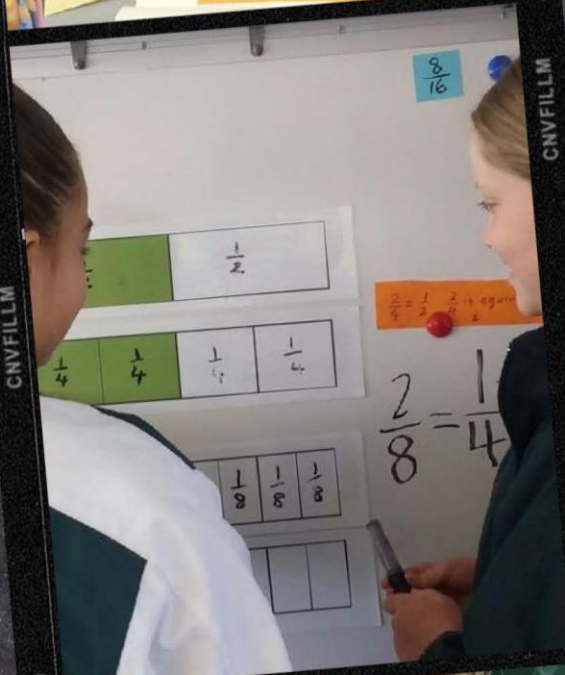
