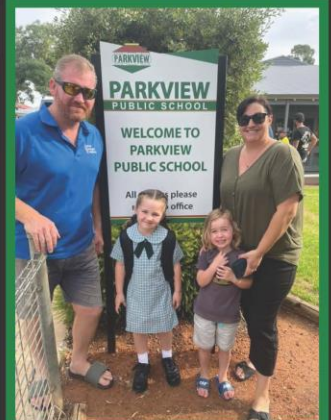
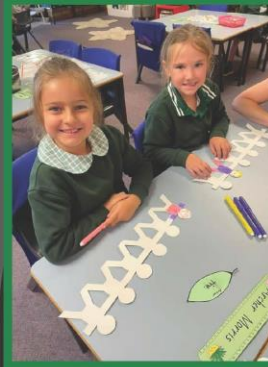

Troy, Bundjalung Goori (East Coast), shared some significant cultural learning for our children which was enjoyed and embraced by all of our students. Thanks is extended to Troy for taking the time to visit our community during such a significant week.

Our cultural learning extended for our Stage 1 students who made the journey to **Fivebough Wetlands** to engage in a **Wiradjuri Wander** under the guidance of Parkview community member and local Wiradjuri leader Mr William Ingram who provided the children with some wonderful learnings linked to the significance of the wetlands and local Wiradjuri culture. There are a host of images available from this experience later in the newsletter and also on our website.

Last week also saw our student leaders make the journey to Wagga Wagga to participate in the **2021 GRIP Leadership Student Conference** in Joyes Hall at Charles Sturt University. Our children had a tremendous day engaging with leaders from across the Riverina.

Wellbeing and Health In-Reach Nurse (WHIN) Coordinator

A WHIN Coordinator has been appointed to service Parkview Public School, Leeton High School and Leeton Public School four days per week starting this week. Our WHIN Coordinator, Jodie Bloomfield, is a registered nurse who will be working across our school, with our learning and support team, to help connect students and families with health and community services.

She is here to help support students and families in addressing health needs, coordinate appropriate assessments and assist with referrals to any needed medical or social services. Jodie is employed by the Local Health District and is one of around 100 similar roles which are being introduced in schools across NSW in a partnership between NSW Health and the Department of Education. 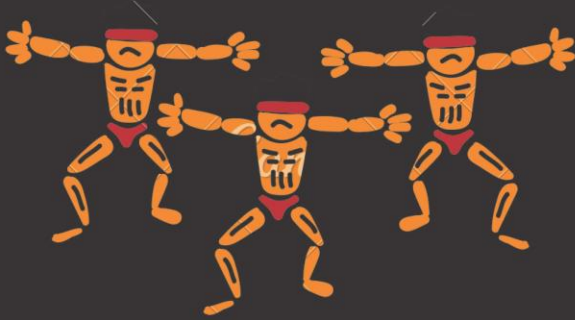
KE goes to the farm!

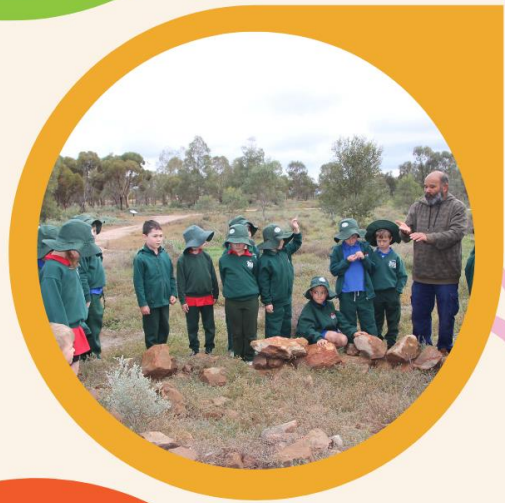

- 'Plum and Hats' screening - to check your child's listening and talking as many Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children

have hearing trouble. This occurs during the first few years of life and can have a lifelong impact.
