






















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PARKVIEW PUBLIC SCHOOL

Welcome to what will be a unique Week 6 at Parkview Public School.

As communicated by the Premier on Saturday, all of NSW has moved into Lockdown with stay at home orders in place. For our school, we have returned to a one model, Online Learing package for children learning from home. All students and families will be supported with Learning from home materials and resources.

Children who **do not** have devices are able to borrow school devices to ensure they can access online learning. **Parents should contact the school should they wish to borrow items.**

There is minimal supervision on site at our school for those students who cannot be educated at home, for example if their parent or carer is an essential worker. If you are working from home, and your child is able to be educated from home, please keep them at home.


We'd also like to remind you to download the <u>NSW school updates app</u> onto your phone, if you haven't already done so, to receive the latest updates about the operational status of your child's school.

School Banking as been temporarily suspended during the current Lockdown. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.


