






















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PARKVIEW PUBLIC SCHOOL

WEEK 7 TERM 3 Commencing Monday 23rd August 2021

Week 7 has arrived at Parkview Public School and with it comes the continuation of the stay at home orders as implemented by the NSW Government in response to the COVID-19 Pandemic. Week 1 of our current learning from home arrangements were typified by outstanding engagement from our students and wonderful support from parents and carers who have adapted so quickly to the learning from home environment.

Children who **do not** have devices are still able to borrow school devices to ensure they can access online learning. **Parents should contact the school should they wish to borrow items.**

Children who cannot access online learning due to internet issues have been provided hard copy work, but the school will also work to help provide internet access to ensure there is no educational disadvantage for any of our children. **Please** contact the school if this applies to you.

We have a busy week in front of us. Please consider the following as you plan your week:

School-based supervision

A reminder that there is minimal supervision on site at our school for those students who cannot be educated at home, for example if their parent or carer is an essential worker. If you are working from home, please keep your children at home in line with public health orders.

Please also note if your children only need to be on site at school for part of the day, we encourage you to pick them up early or drop them off late. Children can be engaged in their Google Classrooms when not at school as all their peers who are at home are.

Zoom Sessions Week 7

All children will have the opportunity to engage in multiple Zoom Sessions with their class mates during this learning week.

We have provided an outline of the timetable in the newsletter, via social media and via email to give parents an overview of what they can expect their children to engage in from a whole class perspective. We have done our best to minimise the number of times multiple children from the same family are scheduled to be in a Zoom!

To connect to these Zoom Conferences, children will be forwarded Zoom Links which they can access via their email accounts (using their DET Portal credentials).

Additional small group Zooms may also be scheduled for children who require additional support. Individual students will be notified of these Zooms prior to them occurring.



School Banking has been temporarily suspended during the current Lockdown. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.



- It will commence downloading immediately

Android/Google Play

- On your SmartPhone open the Android/Google Play market
- Search for our school name
- Press install
- Your app will start installing instantly

To Open Our School App

- Look for our schools app icon on your phone screen
- Press the icon once
- It will open automatically

When prompted select yes to receive notifications and use your location (this will make sure the google maps and pop-up alerts work for you)
