## WEEK 8 TERM 3 Commencing Monday 30<sup>th</sup> August 2021

Welcome to Week 8 of the term at Parkview Public School. This week will be the third consecutive week of our 'Learning from Home' model.

Due to ongoing concerns about community transmission, stay-at-home rules in place for regional NSW will be extended until at least 11:59pm on 10 September. This means that NSW schools continue to operate under current restrictions until at least Friday 10 September.

As a result, our current 'Learning From Home' model will remain in place at Parkview Public School for at least Weeks 8 & 9 of the term (August 30 - September 10).

- Search for our school name
- Press install
- Your app will start installing instantly

### *To Open Our School App*

- Look for our schools app icon on your phone screen
- Press the icon once
- It will open automatically

When prompted select yes to receive notifications and use your location (this will make sure the google maps and pop-up alerts work for you)
