



Having said all of that, our entire staff would like to thank the incredible efforts of parents and carers in homes over the last four weeks which enabled us to successfully deliver online learning experiences for our children. There were many memorable moments from the learning at home period which was highlighted last week by our Virtual Book Week Character Parade and Tech Free Friday!

We have a busy week in front of us as we approach the end of the term. Please consider the following as you plan your week:

Level 3 Return to School COVID Protocols

With the easing of 'Stay at Home' restrictions in the Leeton LGA on Saturday, 11th September, our school has now moved to operating under <u>Level 3 conditions</u> as part of our COVID-safe return to school roadmap. This means all our students were expected to resume face-to-face learning on site from today (Monday, 13th September).

In line with this expectation, there are a number of elements families and students can expect to experience when returning to our school site under COVID-safe Level 3 conditions:

- Parents and carers will need to **remain outside of school grounds** and follow physical distancing and avoid gathering for drop-offs and pick-ups.
- Staff will be required to wear masks indoors and outdoors while on school grounds.
- We will reduce overall mingling of our different student years which means no school assemblies, sport (outside of existing class Sport and PDHPE), excursions or field trips.
- Students will play in stage groups in the playground. This means children will have a timetabled location for play
 throughout Week 10 of the term and necessary modifications will be made for the start of Term 4 if
 required. When arriving at school, children should drop their bags at their classrooms and go directly to their
 scheduled play area.

Use of student toilets will remain the same as usual and this will be communicated to children, among other information, via a virtual school assembly on Monday morning.

- Only essential visitors will be allowed on site and will be required to check-in and wear masks at all times.
- Our School Canteen is open with appropriate hygiene measures in place. Ordering will be available via
 classroom baskets or online ordering (preferred). Children will be informed of the appropriate protocols for
 accessing the canteen at Recess and Lunch when they return to school on Monday.
- Our P&C Uniform Shop is only available for over the phone orders under Level 3 restrictions. If you require any type of uniforms, please ring the school during designated Uniform Shop hours (Monday 9am-10am and Thursday 2pm-3pm) so your order can be processed. Orders can be picked up from the School Administration Office at a time that is identified when you place your orders.
- There will be enhanced daily cleaning of the school and wherever possible we will ensure classrooms will be well-ventilated with open windows.

Loaned Device Return

With the return to face to face learning, we have asked that all devices that were borrowed from the school (iPads, Laptops, Dongles and Charging Cords) be returned to school as soon as possible. If your child was unable to return their device today, we ask that you arrange for them to be returned tomorrow following the protocols outlined below:

- *each child should bring their device to school and return it to their classroom teacher when they enter their class at 9am tomorrow morning.
- *Parents are asked to refrain from entering the school to drop devices at the Administration Office. Our collection strategy centres around children returning borrowed devices to their classrooms. Your assistance with this is greatly appreciated.

We will continue to keep you informed of when we will be able to commence this eagerly anticipated program.

Level 3 restrictions allow for pre-school programs to resume, and as such, our **Bright Beginnings** program resumed today for registered children. We do have limited spaces available in this program so if you would like your child to be a part of Bright Beginnings please contact the school and we will attempt to accommodate your request.
