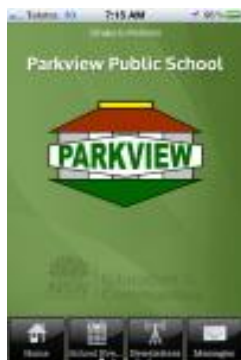

This event is run by the NSW-ACT AFL and no direct supervision is provided by staff from Parkview PS.



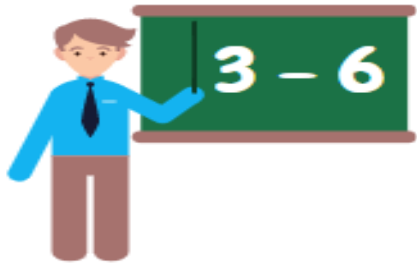
### House Championship 2022
