We wish Blake all the best for this event. More details will be shared on our School Facebook Page closer to the event.

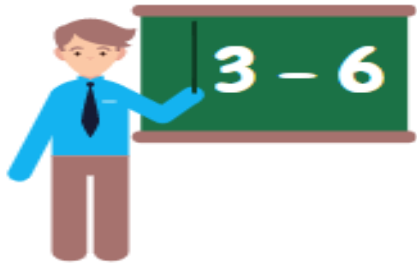


### House Championship 2022
