## Koalas

## Kangaroos



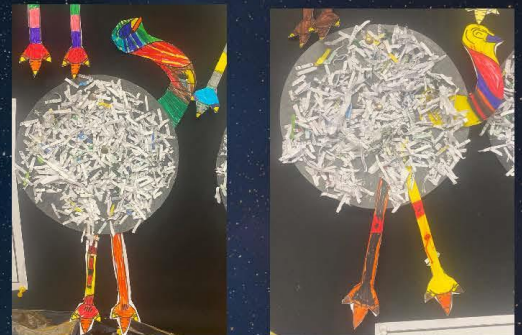

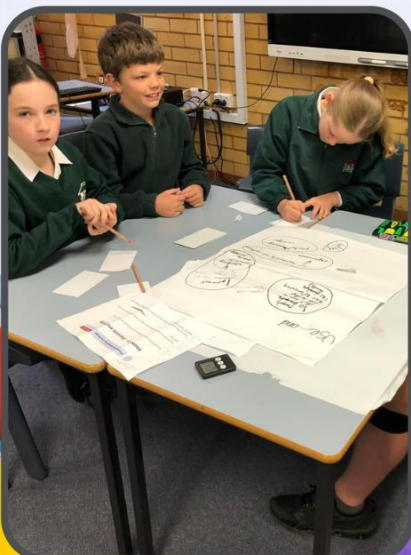
