Riverina PSSA Soccer Quarter Finals

On Tuesday 30 August, the Parkview boys and girls' soccer teams travelled to Deniliquin to compete against Finley in the third round of the NSWSSA Knockout. On an overcast and windy day the girls team took to the sodden pitch first. Finley gained early momentum, maintaining possession in their attacking half. Parkview's defensive line were working overtime with excellent clearing kicks from Miah Weymouth. But Finley were relentless with some strong frames and more powerful kicks surging forward, eventually capitalising in the 8th minute. However, the Parkview girls were not giving up. They began to find their groove and settle into the match, getting a few more opportunities in their attacking end. The Parkview pressure resulted in a penalty play, with Lucy Gilmour jumping on a loose ball and slotting it into the goal to equalise after 17 minutes of play. The battle continued through until half time, with possession moving back and forth, and Zarly Pike putting in a huge effort. The second half continued with the same to-and-fro manner. Sapphire Ward, Emerald Ward and Amethyst Ward working hard to bolster the back line alongside Miah and a brief stint from Airlie Chilko. Ava Weymouth showing great skill and enthusiasm for a Year 3 student was supported by consistent effort from Arla Quigley and Zeanna Johnstone midfield, supported further by Mia Barclay and Miah Bright. Up front, Lucy continued to work for every ball, as well as her sister Ava Gilmour. Joyce Selei was building confidence and making great decisions in the goals. But, when Finley lifted again, the pressure continued, and they scored another goal in the latter part of the second half to take the lead and eventually the win 2-1.



The boys then stepped onto the field and were ready to play. Parkview matched it early with Finley as play moved from end to end. The defensive work from Tyrese Doyle, Blake Mawer, Vann Hodge and Tyreese Fernando prevented Finley from capitalising on some early surges forward. Xavier Chilko controlled the ball through the midfield in both attack and defence, working together with Jack Crowe to provide opportunities up front. Brock Marks, Cooper DeValentin, Deegan Tiffin and Deklan Boots were positioned well in the front but couldn't quite get enough opportunity from a persistent Finley outfit. The tussle between the two teams continued on for the remainder of the first half, going into the break nil-all. Finley began the second half in strong fashion, nailing an early opportunity and putting it passed the keeper to take the lead 1-nil.



Parkview lifted and worked even harder. Chayce Powles led the efforts alongside Xavier and Jack. However, a quick turnover, and a quality strike from Finley, resulted in another goal. Despite Finley's two goals, Kaed Harvie had an excellent game as keeper, saving a number of opportunities and performing some great clearing kicks. The final score, Finley 2, Parkview 0.

All players in both games were displaying excellent sportsmanship and teamwork and should be proud of their efforts.

Parkview's Representative Girls Basketball Team contested the Riverina Quarter Finals of the State Basketball Knockout at the West End Stadium in Griffith today.

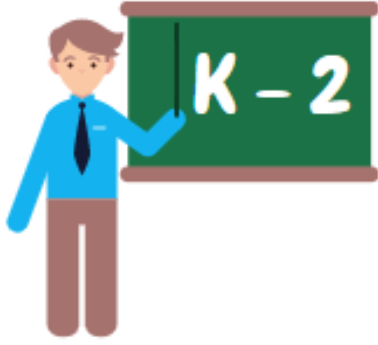
