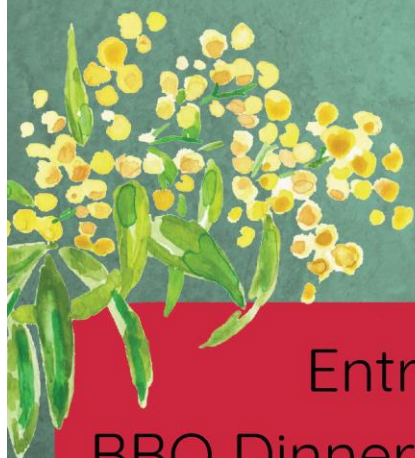

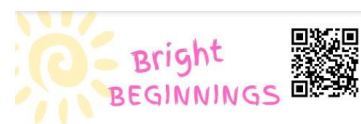

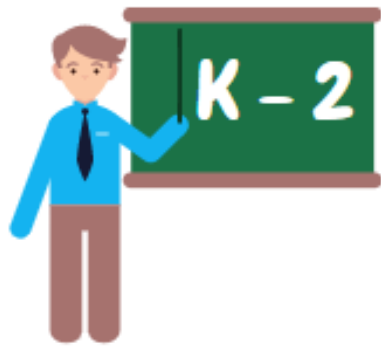


House Championship 2023

We were also lucky enough to have a guest speaker come and talk to us about his trips to Antarctica.

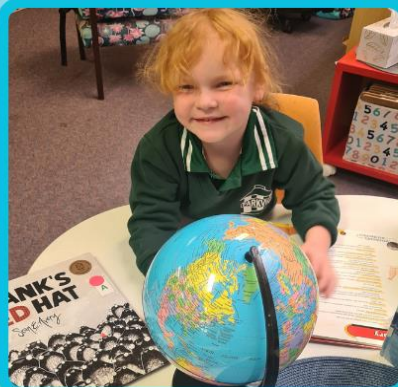

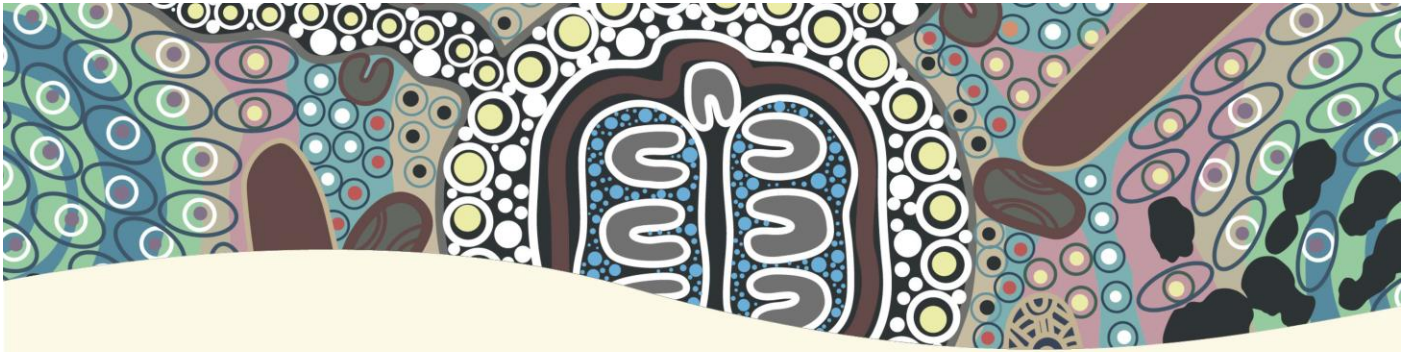
