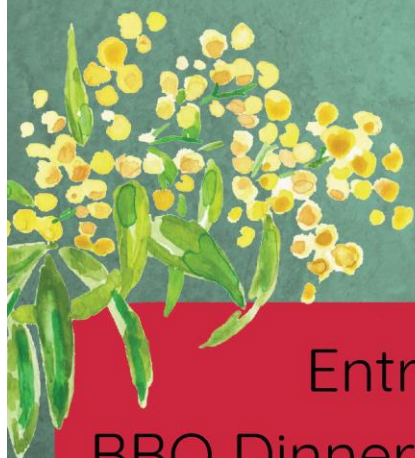

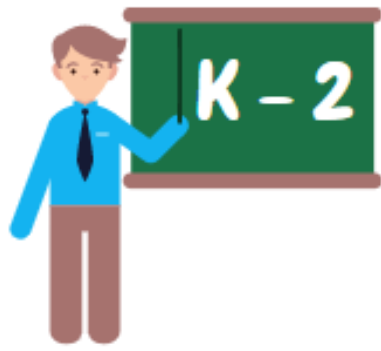


House Championship 2023
