Interested community members are invited to come along and cheer the kids on as they seek to gain vital house points in the battle for the 2023 House Championship which is incredibly close at the moment.

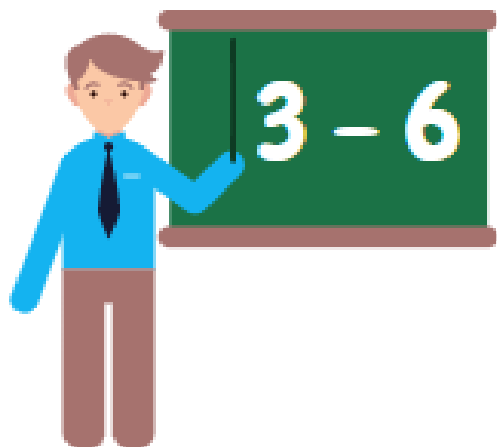


### House Championship 2023

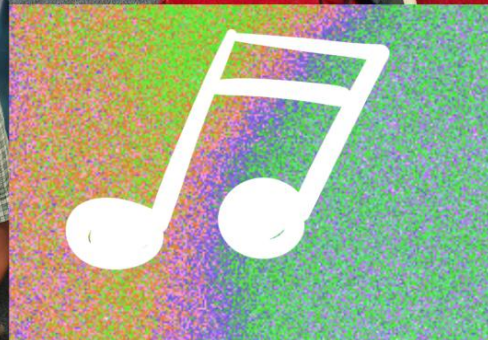

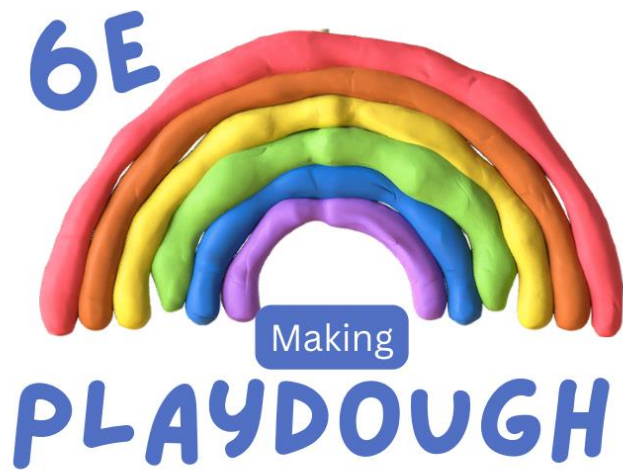
