Congratulations to our finalists and thank you to everyone who took the time to participate in this wonderful tradition.

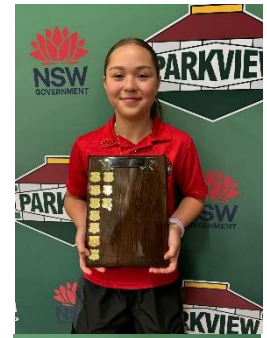

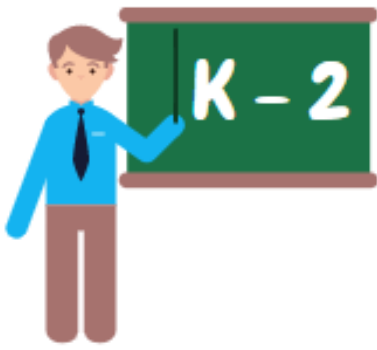
