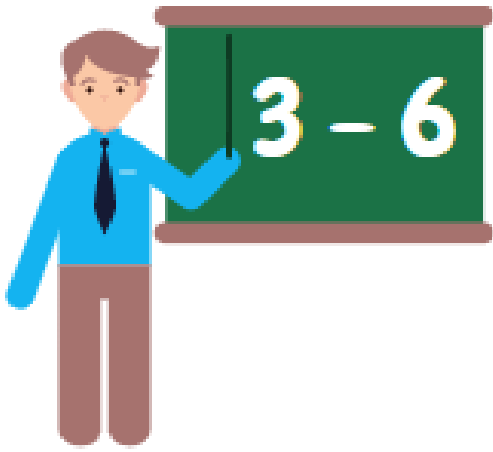
K-2 Movie Excursion Day – Griffith

Infectious Disease Notification

We currently have a confirmed case of Whooping Cough (Pertussis) in our school.

Whooping cough is a serious respiratory infection. It is caused by the bacteria *Bordetella pertussis*. It is also called pertussis.

Whooping cough is very infectious and spreads easily from one person to another. It affects people of all ages and can be life-threatening in babies. Children and adults generally don't get as sick, but can pass it on to babies who are at higher risk. Mothers in their last month of pregnancy should also monitor any coughs closely.

We encourage all families to be vigilant if their child has a cough and get it checked by a doctor as soon as possible.

Please keep your child home if they have a cough.

4. SET ASIDE YOUR COMET.
5. DRAW SEVERAL DIFFERENT-SIZED STARS ON THE BLACK PAPER TO CREATE A SOLAR SYSTEM.
6. TAPE YOUR COMET TO THE PAPER AND DISPLAY IN YOUR FAVOURITE LOCATION.

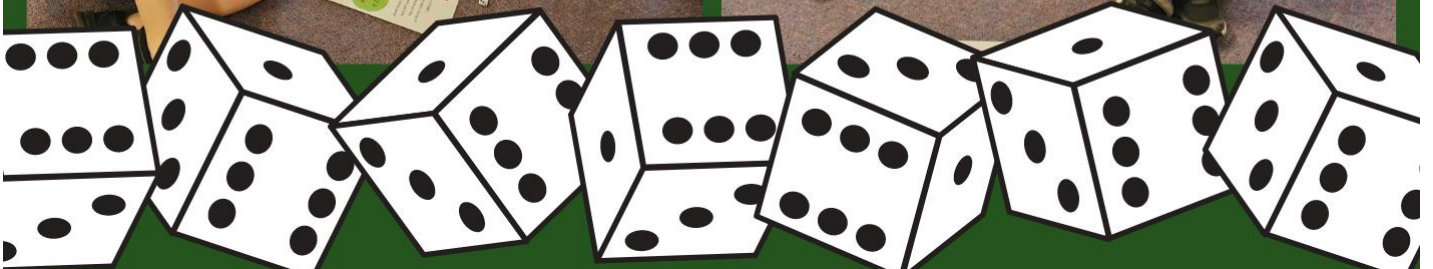

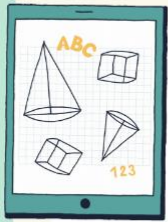

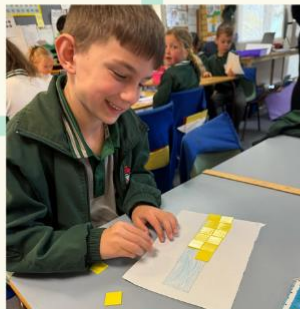
