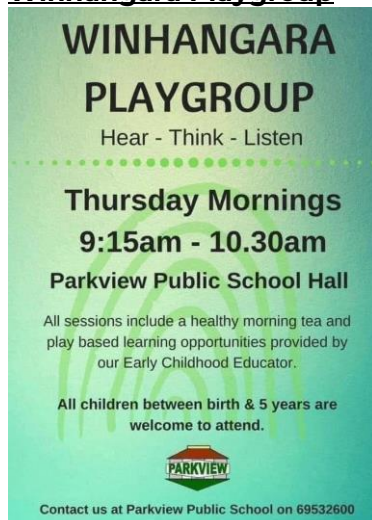

## WIRADJURI LANGUAGE AND CULTURAL CAMP

Ten Stage 3 students represented Parkview at the annual Wiradjuri Language and Cultural Camp, held at Borambola Sports and Recreation Centre.

After being invited to a formal Welcome to Country by Aunty Gail Manderson, and participating in a Smoking Ceremony led by Uncle Pat Connelly, our students

spent the day participating in a variety of workshops focusing on Wiradjuri language, weaving, music and artefacts. It has been a huge day for our kids who are thriving on the opportunity to not only learn about Culture, but also to connect with Aboriginal students from across the region.

Day 2 of the Wiradjuri Language and Cultural Camp at Borambola yesterday was jam-packed with new and exciting interactive workshops that immersed our students in culture.

Students learnt how to count to 10 in Wiradjuri, using this knowledge to play games of Go Fish! They also spent time learning about different fibres in the environment, using stringy bark to weave rope. After lunch, students explored their creative sides, developing their own traditional artworks that represented themselves, their families, and their homes. To round out another huge day, students engaged in a fun filled dance workshop, learning a variety of dance routines and linking them to the Dreaming.

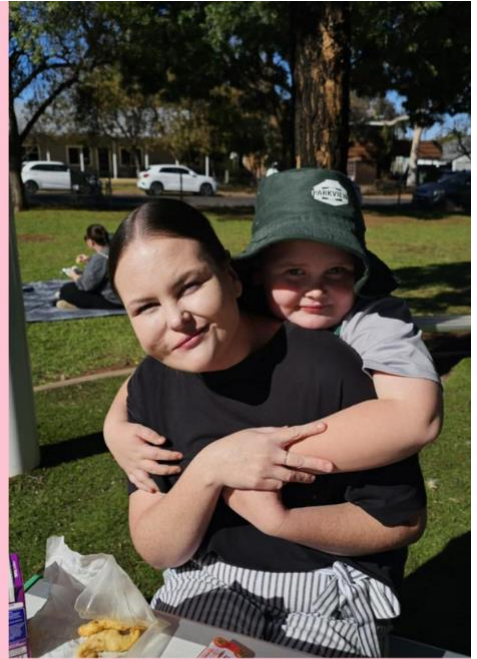
