Our students will be immersed in specific cultural learning experiences to deepen their knowledge linked to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander culture when we host a visit from the team from Sandhills Artefacts on Thursday.

National NAIDOC Week celebrations are held across Australia in the first week of July each year (Sunday to Sunday), to celebrate and recognise the history, culture and achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples. NAIDOC Week is an opportunity for all Australians to learn about First Nations cultures and histories and participate in celebrations of the oldest, continuous living cultures on earth.

In 2025, NAIDOC Week marks a powerful milestone: 50 years of honoring and elevating Indigenous voices, culture, and resilience. The 2025 theme, **"The Next Generation: Strength, Vision & Legacy,"** celebrates not only the achievements of the past but the bright future ahead, empowered by the strength of our young leaders, the vision of our communities, and the legacy of our ancestors.





The last 7 days in our community have been enormous with so many exciting experiences and achievements from our children. Perhaps the most exciting was the achievement of **Jenny Thorpe**. who has been recognised as an award recipient in the **Magic of Wiradjuri Country Photo Competition** — a remarkable achievement that shines a light on both her creativity and her connection to Country.

The Magic of Wiradjuri Country competition, an initiative led by Riverina Local Land Services, invites amateur photographers across our region to capture and celebrate the natural beauty and cultural significance of Wiradjuri Country. Open to both primary and secondary students, the competition encourages young people to share their perspectives through the lens.

Jenny's winning photo stood out for its unique composition and the powerful story it tells about the land we live on and learn from. Her work will now be showcased as part of an official exhibition, alongside other winning entries — a true



testament to her talent and vision. We are incredibly proud of Jenny for representing our school and community with such pride and artistry. Congratulations Jenny, on this well-deserved recognition!
